Your Standard Poodle puppy is no accident!!! He/she is the result of careful research, planning, health testing, and good nutrition. Before leaving our kennel, your puppy has been tattooed, dewormed, vaccinated, and examined by a Veterinarian. If you have a health problem with your puppy, please take him/her to a licensed Veterinarian as soon as possible and contact Khalsa Kennels. If your puppy develops a communicable disease within the incubation period of prior to leaving our kennel, we will reimburse the full purchase price upon return of the puppy. For example, if the puppy came down with Parvo within 5 days of leaving us, it contracted the disease while at our kennel. If however, the puppy developed Parvo symptoms after the recognized incubation period after leaving our kennel, then it had to have contacted the disease after leaving us. Your puppy should have it's first BOOSTER vaccination thirty days after it's first vaccination (the date marked on the puppy's health record), followed by a second booster in another 30 days. Please avoid taking your puppy to areas frequented by other dogs until after it's second booster.

CONDITIONS:

1. Seller has sold purchaser the above named pure-bred Standard Poodle puppy, hereafter referred to as the Poodle, which is guaranteed healthy, for \$_____ plus shipping/transportation expenses if any. The parents of this Poodle are guaranteed to have been health tested and cleared at the time of breeding for the following: Hip Dysplasia, Progressive Retinal Atrophy, von Willibrand's disease, and Sebaceous Adenitis. Certificates will be provided upon request.

The Seller will provide a five generation pedigree on the Poodle as a separate addendum to this contract.

2. The purchaser agrees to keep the Poodle confined from traffic with access to a fenced yard, to be properly sheltered, with adequate food and water, to give love and attention, and to provide regular veterinary care. The purchaser agrees to NEVER allow the Poodle to ride in the open bed of a pickup, ranchero, jeep, or other similar vehicle unless the Poodle is crated or otherwise properly restrained. Purchaser agrees to keep the Poodle clean, groomed, clipped and free of mats. The purchaser agrees to keep the Poodle as a house pet and not as an "outside" pet.

3. The Seller agrees to register the Poodle with the Canadian Kennel Club and forward the registration papers to the purchaser.

4. The purchaser agrees to a Non Breeding Agreement of the Poodle. The Poodle is to be spayed or neutered by the age of six months. The purchaser must provide a copy of the spay/neuter veterinary certificate to the Seller by the time the Poodle is 7 months of age.

5. The purchaser has the option to have the Poodle examined by a licensed veterinarian within 5 working days from the receipt of the Poodle. If a problem is detected by the veterinarian, the purchaser may return the Poodle for a refund of the full purchase price, all shipping costs to be paid by the purchaser. The purchaser agrees to provide a signed statement from the examining veterinarian detailing the health problem. If the purchaser decides to keep the Poodle, the Seller will not be responsible for any veterinary costs incurred. The Seller reserves the right to have the Poodle examined by a veterinarian of the Seller's choice, at Seller's expense, for a second opinion of the condition.

6. If, for any reason, the purchaser can no longer keep the Poodle, ownership will revert to the Seller for no more than the price stated above. Return price is dependent upon the age and condition of the Poodle as determined by a competent veterinarian, and other reliable breeders, and being able to place the Poodle in a new home within 30 days of the Poodle's return. After that time, a kennel fee of \$8 per day will be charged against the purchase price until the Poodle is placed or until the purchase price reaches zero. If the purchaser cannot afford to pay return costs of shipping, the Seller will prepay the cost and deduct it from any refund due. Seller may agree to have the Poodle placed in a new home by the purchaser, with the new home approved by the original Seller. Under no circumstances is the Poodle to be euthanized, or otherwise disposed of without gaining written permission of the Seller. If purchaser changes address or telephone number, purchaser will advise the Seller of the change as soon as possible.

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7. If the purchaser is ever charged or convicted of animal abuse or cruelty by a federal, provincial, state or local authority, the purchaser forfeits all rights to the above named Poodle and will immediately remand custody of the Poodle to the Seller. All CKC registration papers to accompany the Poodle, with the transfer section properly signed by the purchaser. In this case the purchaser will NOT receive any refund of monies paid to the seller.

8. If the Poodle is used for breeding purposes without the above named conditions for the release of the non breeding agreement fulfilled, the purchaser agrees to pay the Seller \$5000.00 in damages.

9. PLEASE NOTE THAT YOUR POODLE WILL REQUIRE A BOOSTER AT ONE YEAR FOLLOWING HIS/HER LAST PUPPY BOOSTER -THEN NO MORE VACCINATIONS FOR THREE TO FIVE YEARS !

No provisions in this contract may be altered or amended without the written approval of both the Seller and the purchaser.
